■ ***Training for the Dethronement. The Example of Cheating Behavior in Schools***

Keywords: *cheating behavior, academic dishonesty, performance goal, frustration, adaptive tactics*

Academic dishonesty is intentional participation in deceptive practices regarding one's academic work and it has become a widespread problem among adolescents.
