

THE PROBLEM OF THE EOCENE/OLIGOCENE BOUNDARY,
ON THE BASIS OF OSTRACOD FAUNAL STUDIES

Summary

On the basis of European ostracod faunal studies of the last decade, it is shown, that some authors follow the use of the classical Lower Oligocene stage /Lattorfian = Sannoisian = Tongrian/, others regard this unit as of Upper Eocene, and a third group of workers represents the view, that this unit represents the basal part of the lower /Rupelian/ stage of the bipartite Oligocene.

The ostracod faunal studies, which have been done so far on the Hungarian Oligocene seem to prove this third view.
