

THE PRESENT STATUS OF THE STRATIGRAPHY IN HUNGARY.
REFLECTIONS ON THE INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITY
IN THE STRATIGRAPHICAL SCIENCES

Abstract

The present paper gives a review of the developments in the stratigraphy of Hungary and of the world in the recent years.

In these years the most favourable result was the publication of the International Stratigraphical Guidebook (1976), and that was followed by the developing of the program of the Classification Subcommittee of the International Committee of Stratigraphy. A nomenclature of the magnetostratigraphy has been prepared, and there are some advances in the stratigraphical classification and nomenclature of the magmatic and metamorphic rocks too.

The Hungarian Committee of Stratigraphy has published its directives in 1975, imitating the international ones. Our present paper describes the recent results in the lithostratigraphical classification of Hungary, the work of the subcommittees of stratigraphy, and gives an outline of their most important tasks in the present.
